**seeking Christ?** If you would like to open your heart to Christ or learn more about a relationship with Him, please speak to the prayer ministers or to our pastor, John Byerly.

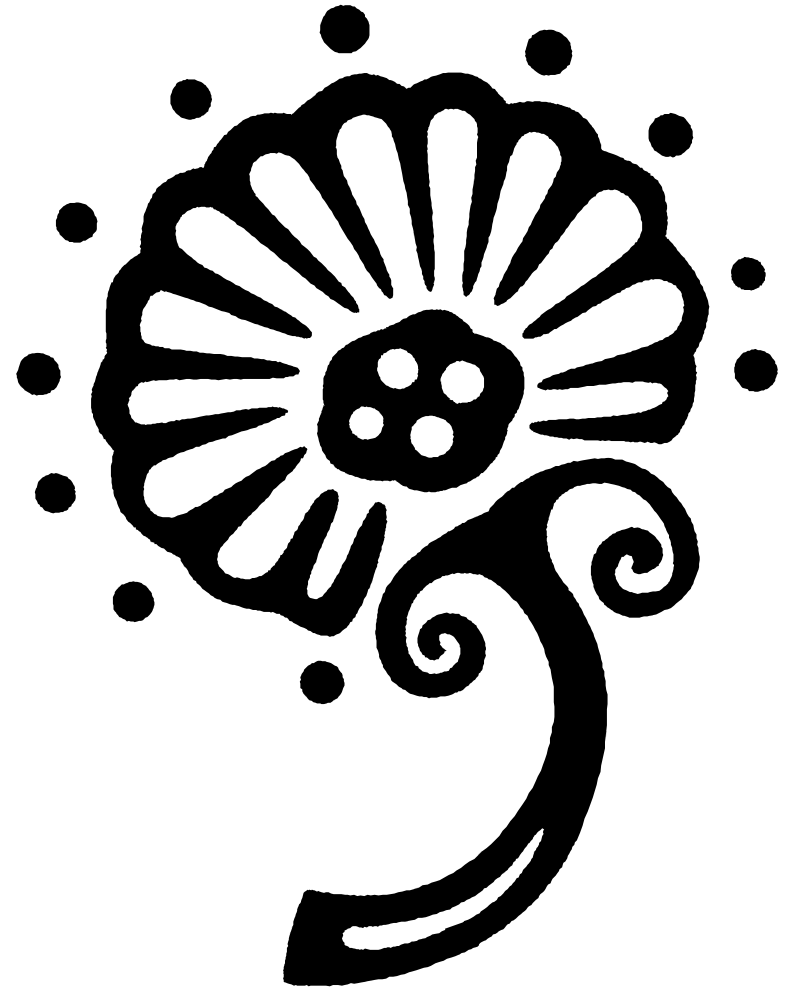
**membership.** If you would like to join our warm and friendly church family, please speak to our pastor, John, or to an usher after the service.
